

THINGS TO PAINT IN JEFFERSON WISCONSIN

And Discounts Provided by Local Businesses

Brickhaus Café – 126 E Milwaukee St

Old world charm, hometown warmth. The Café is housed in a beautifully restored storefront. *Present your Plein Air Artist name badge and receive 25% off your food and beverage.*

Rotary Park – 301 S Gardner St

Rotary Park runs along the Rock River with entrances at Gardner and Milwaukee Streets. Free concerts are held in the bandshell on Thursday evenings during the summer. The concert June 28th at 7:00pm is the Palmyra-Eagle Community Band. Food and beverages are available during the concert. *Present your Plein Air Artist name badge at the bar and receive two free beer tickets.*

Woolen Mills at Jefferson Area Business Center – 222 S Wisconsin Dr

Large facility on the Rock River with historic roots to woolen mills. This facility is where the gallery and sale will be on June 30th and July 1st.

Rock Bottom Saloon and Eatery – 123 W Milwaukee St

The Rock Bottom is housed in a historic train depot next to Rotary Park. *Present your Plein Air Artist name badge to receive a free beverage with an entrée or sandwich order.*

River's Edge Nature Preserve – along the Rock River and S Whitewater Ave. Go east on Dane St from Main St. Dane becomes S Whitewater Ave. This preserve was founded just two years ago in honor of Scott Fischer, a loyal and hardworking member of the community of Jefferson. This park is also home to a Monarch waystation.

Pedestrian bridge across the Rock River at Milwaukee St – this iconic bridge connects the east and west sides of the Rock River downtown, next to Rotary Park.

Jefferson Farmers Market – Parking lot on the corner of Racine St and Center St on Thursday (6/29) from Noon to 5pm.

Heron's Landing – 200 W Milwaukee St

This building was originally built in 1898 and sits on the banks of the Rock River overlooking Rotary Park. It was beautifully restored in 2008.

Fort Community Credit Union – 100 N Main St

Jefferson was once a hub for breweries with five operating in the community around 1870. This was once the home of Breunig Brewery. One of the old tunnels can still be seen at this location.

Center Avenue Studio – 123 N Center St

Once a part of Heger Bottling Works, this historic building is now the home, studio, and gallery of artist Terrence Coffman.

Jefferson Farmers Market – Parking lot on the corner of Center Ave and Racine St. on Thursdays from Noon to 5pm starting June 8th.

St John the Baptist Catholic Church – 324 E North St

St John's Lutheran Church – 232 E Church St

Immanuel United Methodist Church – 201 E Racine St

St Mark's Lutheran Church – 324 S Sanborn Ave

Christberg Church – Hwy 18 and Christberg Rd (East of Jefferson)

St Lawrence Catholic Church – W4926 Hwy 18 – *There is a group home south of the church. We have been requested to not go on their property for parking or painting near that group home for privacy purposes.*

St Coletta of Wisconsin – N4637 Co Rd Y

St. Coletta of Wisconsin is a provider of support services for adults with developmental disabilities and other challenges throughout their lifespan. Beautifully maintained buildings and grounds from the early 1900's.

Jefferson Marsh Wildlife Area - To find the wildlife area travel east of Jefferson on US Hwy 18 about one mile and watch for a parking lot on the south side of the road. Another option is to head east of Jefferson on US Hwy 18 and turn south on county Hwy Y. Continue approximately 2.5 miles southeast on Highway Y to 3 different parking lots centrally located within the property.

Fidelity Land Title Ltd – 309 S Main St

The title company is housed in the former St Mary's Episcopal Church and the Historic Andrew Carnegie City Library. The two buildings are connected by a two-story glass atrium.

Riverfront Park – 589-729 S Wisconsin Dr

Community park on the Crawfish River. The park features 3 baseball diamonds, 2 lighted basketball courts, 2 lighted hard surface tennis courts, Skate Park Central (skateboard park) and the Playland of Dreams.

Former Vetro Winery – 1414 Vino Lane

This property was recently purchased, and the winery is closed. We have permission from the property owner to paint on the property. There is a very nice gazebo and great views. Plans are for this to become a brewery, cidery, and distillery. There may be some production started by the time of the Plein Air in the former winery building.

Wedl's Hamburger & Ice Cream Parlor – 200 E Racine St

This hometown establishment has been serving hamburgers with a secret recipe since 1916. *Present your Plein Air Artist name badge and receive a free soda and fries with the purchase of any burger.*

Bon-Ton Bakery – 115 E Racine St

Celebrating its 100th year in business, this 5th generation bakery uses old world skills and the best ingredients and makes everything from scratch. *Present your Plein Air Artist Name Badge for 20% of your bakery order.*

Wine and Roses – 215 S Center St – Renovated home now housing a floral shop that also sells wine and wine and beer making supplies.
