

# THINGS TO PAINT IN JEFFERSON WISCONSIN

**Jefferson County Fair** – 503 N Jackson Ave – As detailed in the prospectus, you can paint at the County Fair on Wed, Thur and Fri morning within the ticketed area. You may paint in areas open to the public inside and outside the buildings from 8am to 10pm. This year you will receive a wrist band for access to the Fair Park. Parking is changing this year. You will receive details at check-in.

**Pedestrian bridge across the Rock River at Milwaukee St** – this iconic bridge connects the east and west sides of the Rock River downtown, next to Rotary Park. Colored lights have been added to the bridge at night. The lights come on at sunset.

**Dorthy Carnes County Park** – N3220 Radloff Ln, Fort Atkinson – This 514 acre park protects land around Rose Lake and has 9 miles of trails with great views of Rose Lake.

**Twice Baked Pottery** – 235 S Main St - newly renovated building on the corner of Dodge and Main St that now houses a pottery shop that formerly resided in Racine.

**Jelli's Market** – N5648 S Farmington, Helenville – A farm market that originally started as a strawberry field and now also grows blueberries, raspberries, asparagus, sweet corn, apples and more. Strawberry season started early with the hot weather this spring so the peak will probably be over but there are plenty of other crops coming in.

**Brickhaus Café** – 126 E Milwaukee St

Old world charm, hometown warmth. The Café is housed in a beautifully restored storefront.

**Rotary Park** – 301 S Gardner St

Rotary Park runs along the Rock River with entrances at Gardner and Milwaukee Streets.

**Woolen Mills at Jefferson Area Business Center** – 222 S Wisconsin Dr

Large facility on the Rock River with historic roots to woolen mills.

**Rock Bottom Saloon and Eatery** – 211 S Gardner St

The Rock Bottom is housed in a historic train depot next to Rotary Park.

**Stable Rock Winery and Distillery** – 123 W Milwaukee St

Newly renovated winery and distillery (and great food) in a historic building overlooking the Rock River.

**River's Edge Nature Preserve** – 843 S Whitewater Ave

This preserve was founded in honor of Scott Fischer, a loyal and hardworking member of the community of Jefferson on the site of his former business (now located on Main St). This park is also home to a Monarch waystation.

**Heron's Landing** – 200 W Milwaukee St

This restaurant is in a building that was originally built in 1898 and sits on the banks of the Rock River overlooking Rotary Park. It was beautifully restored in 2008.

**Fort Community Credit Union** – 100 N Main St

Jefferson was once a hub for breweries with five operating in the community around 1870. This was once the home of Breunig Brewery. One of the old tunnels can still be seen at this location.

**St John the Baptist Catholic Church** – 324 E North St

**St John's Lutheran Church** – 232 E Church St

**Immanuel United Methodist Church** – 201 E Racine St |

**St Mark's Lutheran Church** – 324 S Sanborn Ave |

**Christberg Church** – Hwy 18 and Christberg Rd (East of Jefferson)

**St Lawrence Catholic Church** – W4926 Hwy 18 – *There is a group home south of the church. We have been requested to not go on their property for parking or painting near that group home for privacy purposes.*

**St Coletta of Wisconsin** – N4637 Co Rd Y

St. Coletta of Wisconsin is a provider of support services for adults with developmental disabilities and other challenges throughout their lifespan. Rose Kennedy lived here for many years. Beautifully maintained buildings and grounds from the early 1900's.

**Jefferson Marsh Wildlife Area** - To find the wildlife area travel east of Jefferson on US Hwy 18 about one mile and watch for a parking lot on the south side of the road. Another option is to head east of Jefferson on US Hwy 18 and turn south on county Hwy Y. Continue approximately 2.5 miles southeast on Highway Y to 3 different parking lots centrally located within the property.

**Fidelity Land Title Ltd** – 309 S Main St

The title company is housed in the former St Mary's Episcopal Church and the Historic Andrew Carnegie City Library. The two buildings are connected by a two-story glass atrium.

**Riverfront Park** – 589-729 S Wisconsin Dr

Community park on the Crawfish River. The park features 3 baseball diamonds, 2 lighted basketball courts, 2 lighted hard surface tennis courts, Skate Park Central (skateboard park) and the Playland of Dreams.

**Wedl's Hamburger & Ice Cream Parlor** – 200 E Racine St

This hometown establishment has been serving hamburgers with a secret recipe since 1916

**Bon-Ton Bakery** – 115 E Racine St

Celebrating its 100<sup>th</sup> year in business, this 5<sup>th</sup> generation bakery uses old world skills and the best ingredients and makes everything from scratch.

**Wine and Roses** – 215 S Center St – Renovated home now housing a floral shop that also sells wine and wine and beer making supplies.

**Olsen-Gibson Funeral Home** – 221 S Center St – A historic building in Jefferson that has been a funeral home for many years.

**Old Jefferson Firehouse** – 148 E Milwaukee St

Originally this was the site of blacksmith shops in the 1850's and 60's. The Village of Jefferson bought the site in 1869 for a town hall and fire engine garage. The building was built in 1872 and has had additions over the years. It is currently the offices of FOCUS Co-working and Lawton & Cates.

**Rock River Landing Park** – 424 N Elizabeth Ave

Newly developed park on the Rock River. Includes restroom facilities and easy parking.

**Tensfelt Park** – South Tensfelt Ave

The southerly portion of the park, located along South Tensfeldt Avenue. The north side of the park is along East Riverview Drive and provides a self pay boat launching facility, restrooms and a parking lot for vehicles and trailers.

**Crawfish River Park** – Hwy 18 east of the Hwy 26 bypass

A group of individuals formed the Friends of Crawfish River Park to raise money and develop this new park. Parking is limited right on Hwy 18 (Racine St) but if you want a secluded piece of nature this is the ticket.

**Glacial Drumlin Trail** – 52 miles of trail between Cottage Grove and Waukesha
